MASKK was established in 1999 and since then we have been a continually growing organisation and charity that engages over 2,000 children per year through play and events.

We provide direct additional support to an average of 250 children and their families each year through safeguarding, holiday hunger, advice and guidance, confidence building and subsidised childcare to enable parents to work or train. Including and supporting children with Special Educational Needs and/or Disabilities at all our activities and through additional tailored sessions to ensure no child is left out.



Working in an area with disadvantaged communities, Manor is amongst the 10% most deprived in our country, some parts within the 1%, means we have an ongoing reliance on donations, grants and in-kind support to continue our work.

MASKK have developed a range of income generating activities to reduce our reliance on grants and now generate 80% of our income from fees, contracts and member donations. But to continue our work, and to generate the missing 20% of the income we need ongoing help.
